How to get help to make a complaint about health or care services in Enfield





There are two main advocacy services in Enfield.

POhWER



and EDA (Enfield Disability Action)





Both of them are FREE.

You do not need to pay to use them.



Let's look at POhWER first





POhWER can help explain things to you and what choices you have.





Help you to write a letter.







Go with you to meetings.





And help take things further if you are not happy.





They can also help you fill in a referral form online.





There are some things they can't help with. Such as:

Investigate your complaint.







Or if the problem happened longer than one year ago.





Or if it is Private Health Care (that is a service you pay for).







And they can't give legal or medical advice.

Now let's look at EDA

(Enfield Disability Action)





EDA can check letters that you have written.



They can listen to your phone call.



Write letters for you or help you write them.



Make phone calls for you.





If it is complicated, they can refer you to another organisation, such as a law centre.

They will ask you information and fill out a referral form.







They will find someone to help you. They might be from EDA or a different organisation. For example.
